


Brand New Daily Summary - Class Teachers

- There is a new popup to see which students are Ready to **Learn** under the final summary ring.


















Brand New Daily Summary - School Admin

- See students by class who are In a state of processing or Not quite ready to learn
















New Look - School Staff Management






New Getting Started Modules






Expired Invitation? - Request a new one
