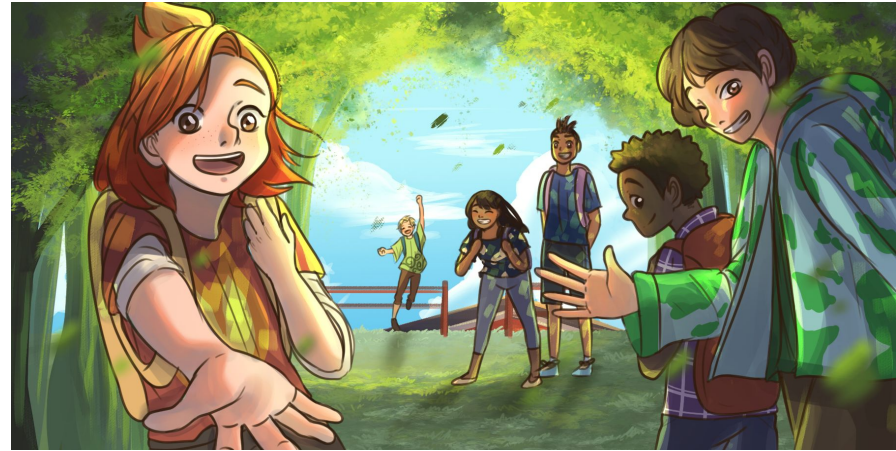

This release includes major improvements to Lessons and Resources in Life Skills GO and structural improvements to enhance user experience.

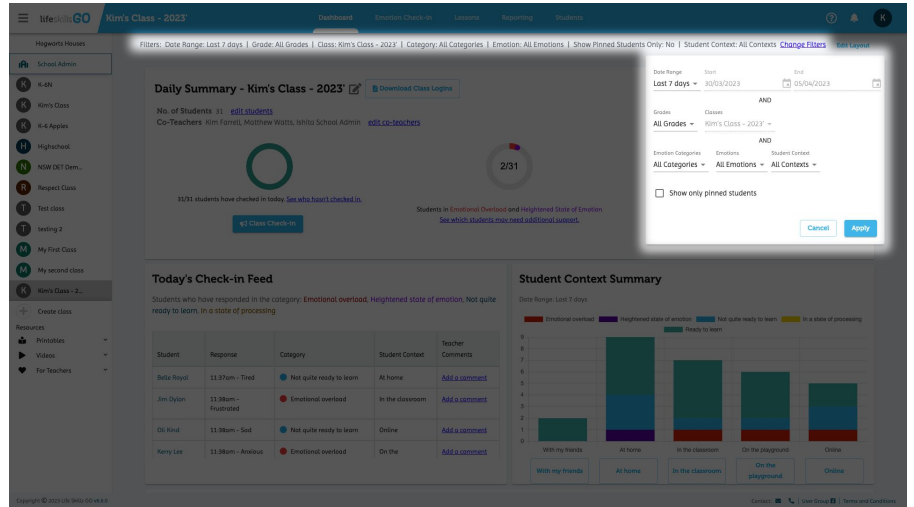

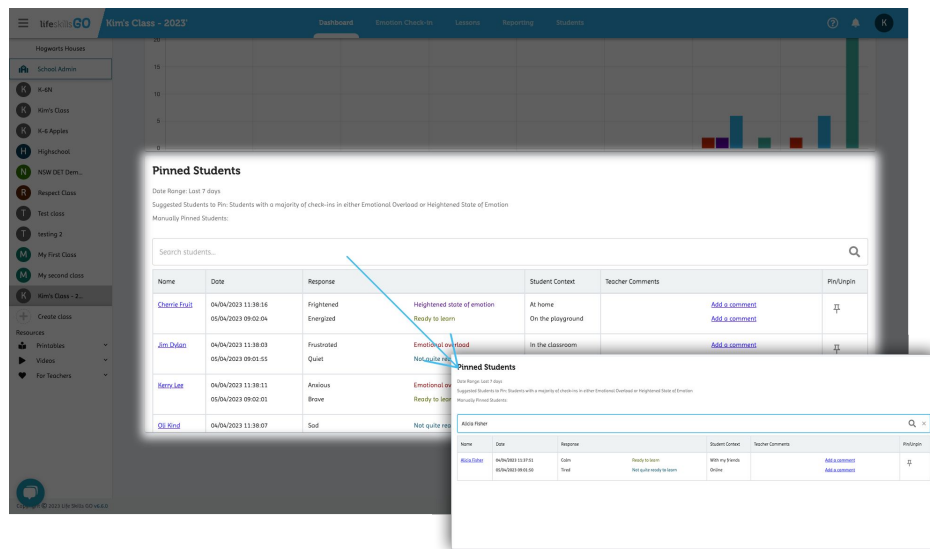

New Pinned Student Card for Teachers

The new Pinned Student card enables teachers to maintain visibility over students that may need additional support based off their check-in responses.

The pinned student card allows teachers to manually pin identified students to their dashboard, view suggested students to pin and search for students in their class to see their data.

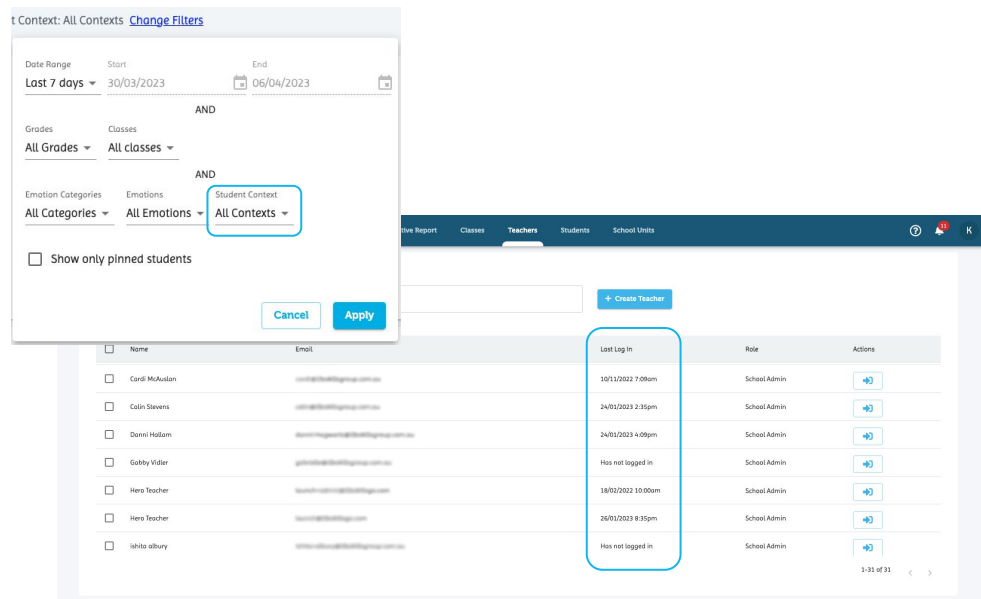

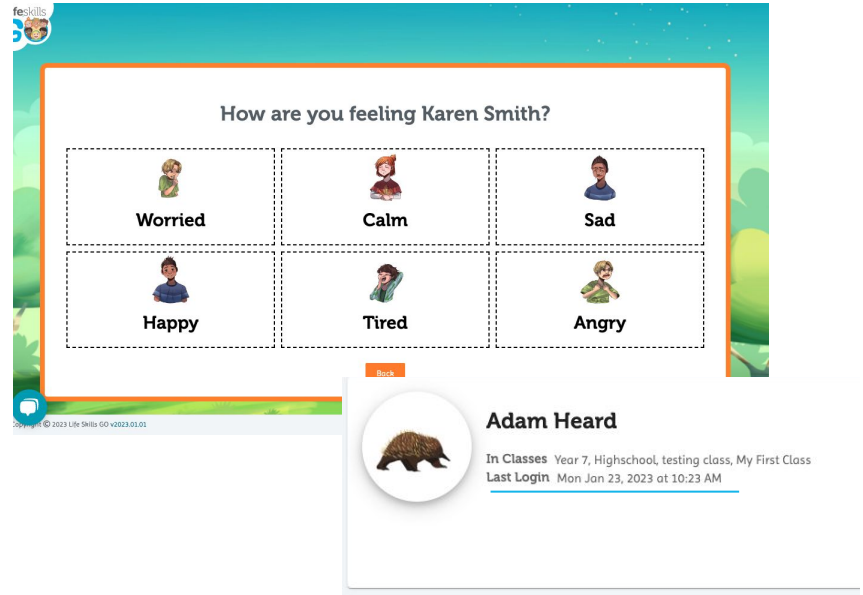

- Some of our teachers were reporting that the foundation for Emotion Literacy check-in appeared too large for the screen they were using. This meant that students had to scroll to view additional emotions. We have fixed the scale of the check-in so that all emotions now appear on the screen at the same time.
- The Last login for students was not appearing correctly in the school admin section and the student profile. This has now been fixed to reflect when each student last logged in to their account.
