


Major Update to the Check-in Settings

We have completely redesigned the check-in settings modal, simplifying it so that it is clear what theses settings will change during the student check-in. With clear visuals to indicate the functionality of the setting, this enhancement will allow educators to quickly customise the check-in to suit the needs of their class and know exactly what students will see the next time they access the check-in. Teachers can also hover over the question mark icon for more information.

This modal is now accessible from the Sentral Attendance page in the Life Skills GO Class Summary card.








Changes to the Life Skills GO Class Summary

We have made a few changes on the Life Skills GO Class Summary Card to ensure that Life Skills GO integration is user friendly, accessible and provides increased visibility over student wellbeing data.

- The **check-in settings** have been added to the Summary card so that teachers using Sentral are able to customise how students complete check-ins without needing navigate to another platform.
- The **Download Class Logins** now exports a PDF that contains up to 6 QR / usernames and passwords per page so that teachers can distribute login credentials to their class in an environmentally conscious manner. This has replaced the previous download that would export individual login cards for students at one per page.
 - This download also includes login instructions for your students that you can print out or distribute on your LMS so that they can easily access Life Skills GO on individual devices.
- **Journal entries** in the Activity Feed now appear highlighted in **Orange** to make it easier for teachers to identify when they are scrolling through the feed.






New Student Check-in Export for Admin

To provide administrators with greater visibility over every student check-in so that no student falls through the cracks, we have included an export of student check-ins to the executive report. This export can also be found in the **Life Skills GO Checkins card** under the wellbeing section of Sentral.

Based off the filters applied to the executive report; executive teams, wellbeing officers, counsellors and stage leaders can process the data to suit their needs, creating custom visualisations to present to staff.




Life Skills GO / Sentral Integration on iOS devices
