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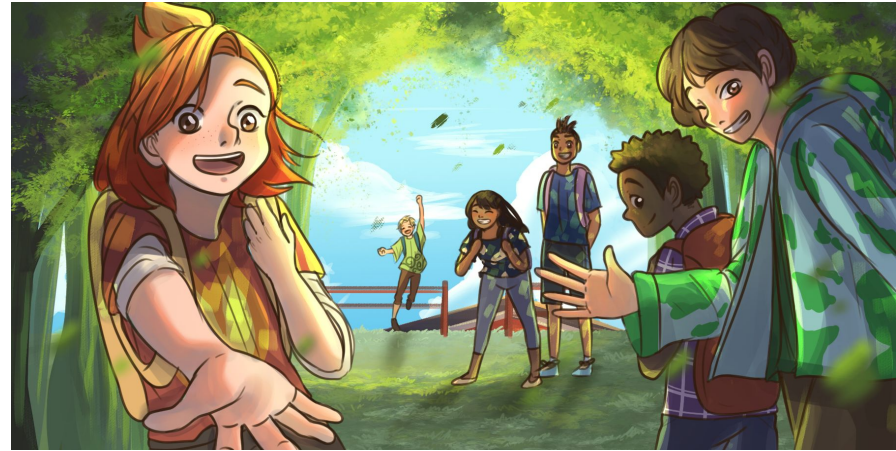

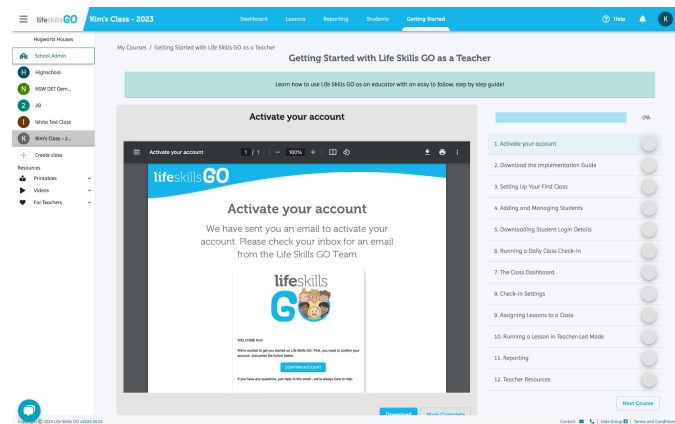


# New Training modules for Teachers and Admin

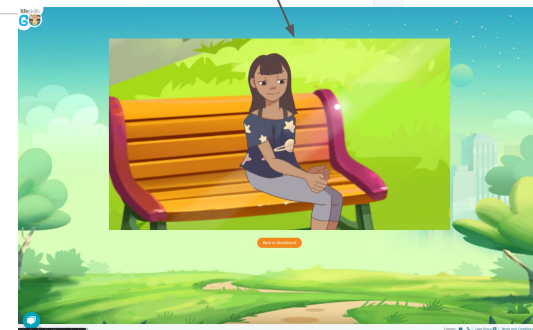
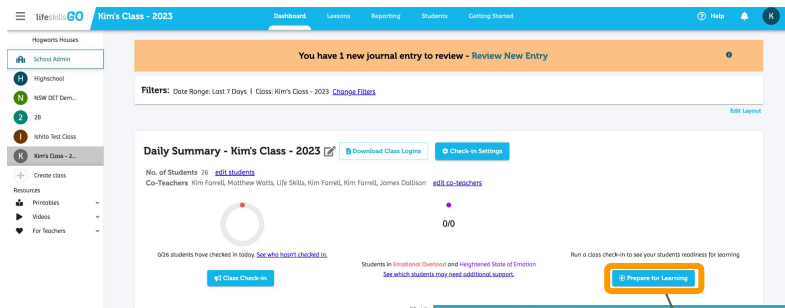


# Prepare for Learning Activity

# Updates to the Classes page for School Admin

To give school administrators more control over their classes setup on Life Skills GO, the **Classes** section of the school admin dashboard has been modified to allow the assignment of teachers to classes. This removes the need to view a class before adding co-teachers.

We have also added the ability to create a new class and assign staff and students from this area as well.
