




Emotion Check-In Data Export

Emotion Check-In data export has been completely redesigned to make data analysis more efficient. The export is ready to download at a 10x faster speed to instantaneously provide you with the insights you need for your class. Additionally, the export includes teacher and student comments made against the check-in responses.







Emotion Check-In Legacy Design

To make your transition to the new export design smoother as well as allow us to continually improve the user experience, we will continue to provide support for the original Emotion Check-In export design. You can switch between the two design options through 'Use new check-in export' toggle on you Emotion Check-In dashboard in the Teacher App.





Student Login Cards

You can now download student login cards from your dashboard by clicking 'Download Class Logins' buttons. Quickly get your students logged into their accounts by using these new cards which boast a large QR code for easy scanning as well as clickable links which will log them straight into their Student App.

These individual PDFs are downloaded as a .zip folder which can be used to distribute logins to each student as soft copies or printouts.





Removal of Support for Older Devices

In an ongoing effort to provide you with a stable and secure platform, we have had to remove support for older phones, tablets and laptops.

We anticipate that this change will have no impact on any of our end users, however, if you do find that your ability to access Life Skills GO has been impacted, please reach out to us at support@lifeskillsgroup.com.au and we would be happy to assist you.

As always, we recommend that you use the latest version of browser and operating system of choice. Life Skills GO runs best on Google Chrome, however, we support all major modern browsers and devices.



Bug Fixes

We have identified and fixed a few minor software bugs in the system including:

- Assigning students to a class occasionally did not correctly save, causing the student to "go missing".
- The sending of invitations or password reset emails sometimes failed due to a DNS error. This has been rectified.

We are also aware of and working on the following:

- Some users experience an app crash when revisiting the site after a prolonged period away
- Some users on new MacBook computers with Apple Silicon cannot access some features.



Platform Updates

Structural updates are part of an ongoing process to help us provide you with a platform that is stable and secure. We routinely update our systems and processes to do the same so that our customers get the best service possible.
