This release includes major improvements to Lessons and Resources in Life Skills GO and structural improvements to enhance user experience.

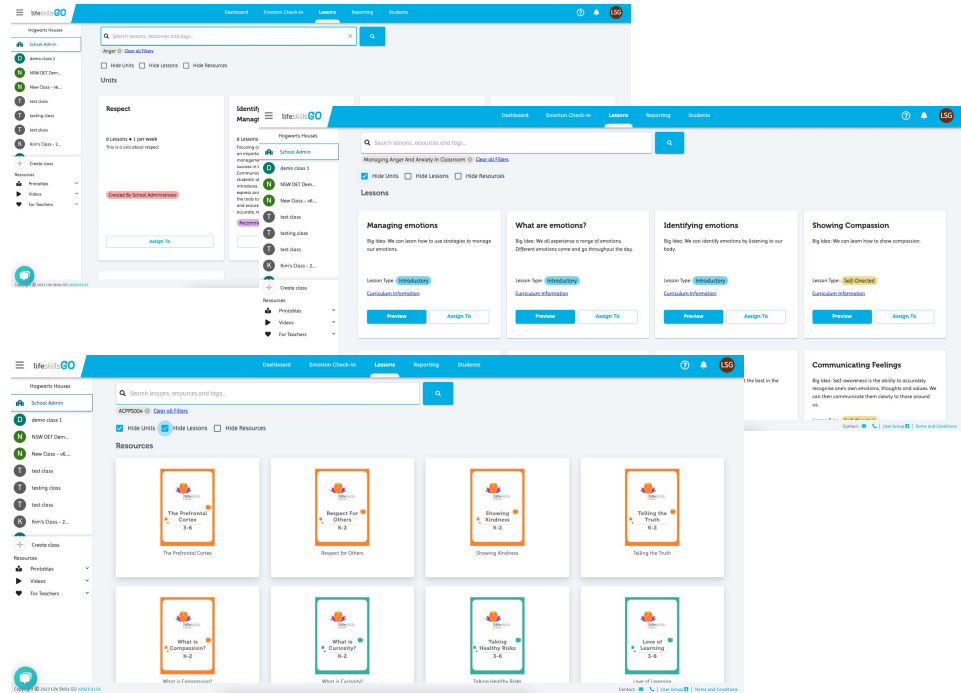

The Lessons Dashboard has been completely redesigned! Upon receiving feedback from educators, we have redesigned the way users search and assign lessons and units.

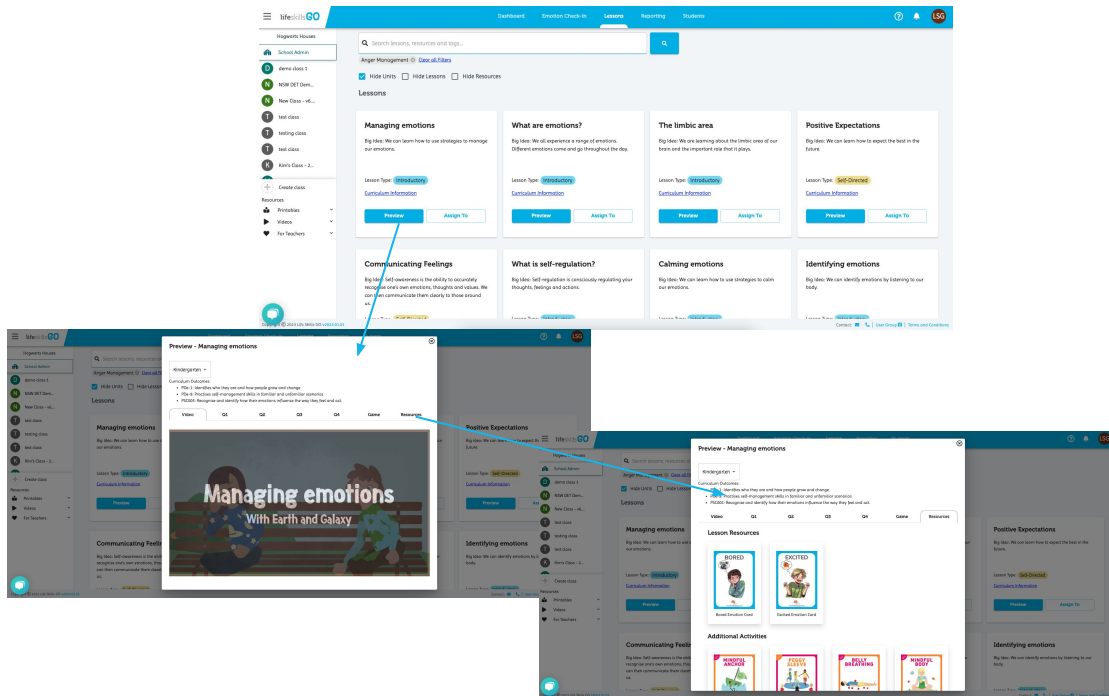
- **Search**

- **Lesson Planning Made Easier**

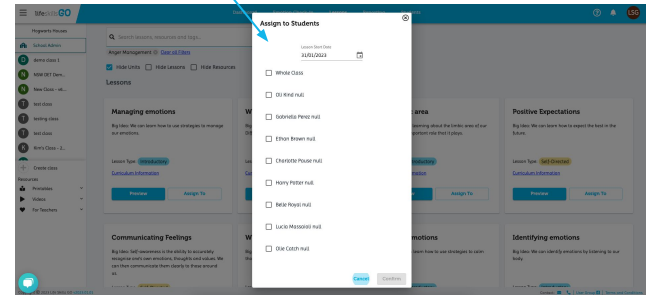
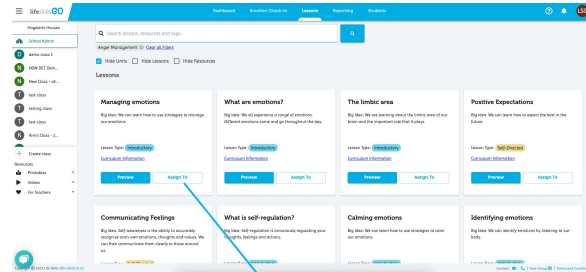
To make lesson planning easier for educators, we have put everything they need in one place! The lesson preview now shows the curriculum codes, activities as well as the resources associated with it.

The educators can now cater to individual student's needs with individualized learning plans for each student in a class. The lessons can be assigned to a single or a group of students and even to the whole class.

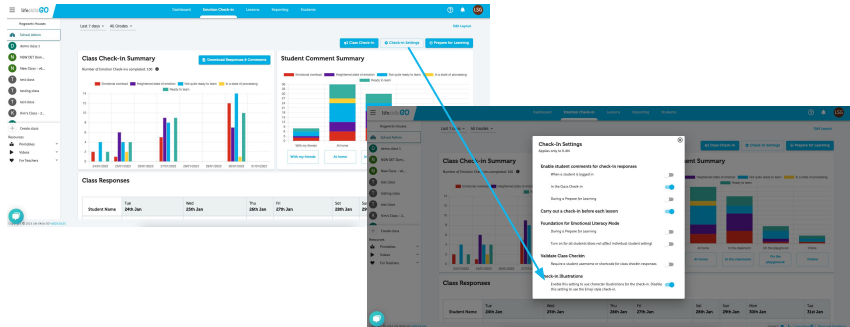
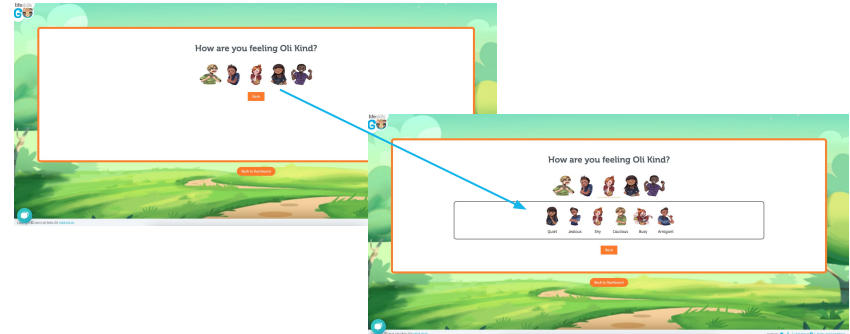
The lessons will be available to students on the chosen date making it easier for educators to plan their term in advance.



Emotion Check-in Illustrations

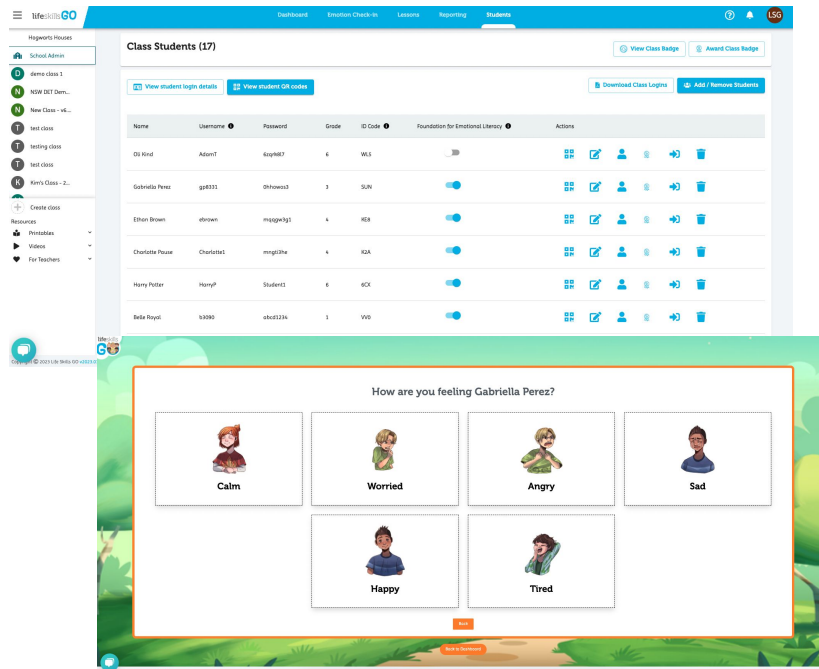
A new version of the Emotion Check-in is now available to users! To help students recognise emotions through facial expressions and body language, we have integrated Life Skills GO characters into the Check-in.

The educators can toggle between the existing emojis and new illustrations through their Class Check-in Settings in the Emotion Check-in Dashboard.



To help students get familiar with emotional literacy, the educators can toggle on Foundation for Emotional Literacy option for them. This used to be known as the Learning Support option.

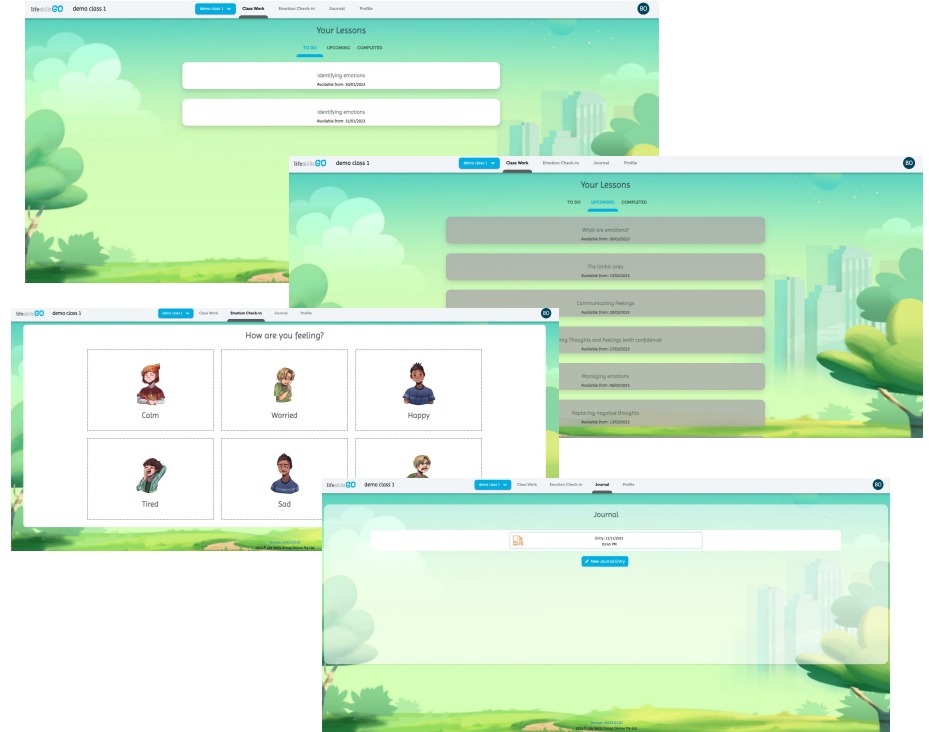
This version of check-in has 6 basic emotions to make it easier for educators to build a foundation for their students.
