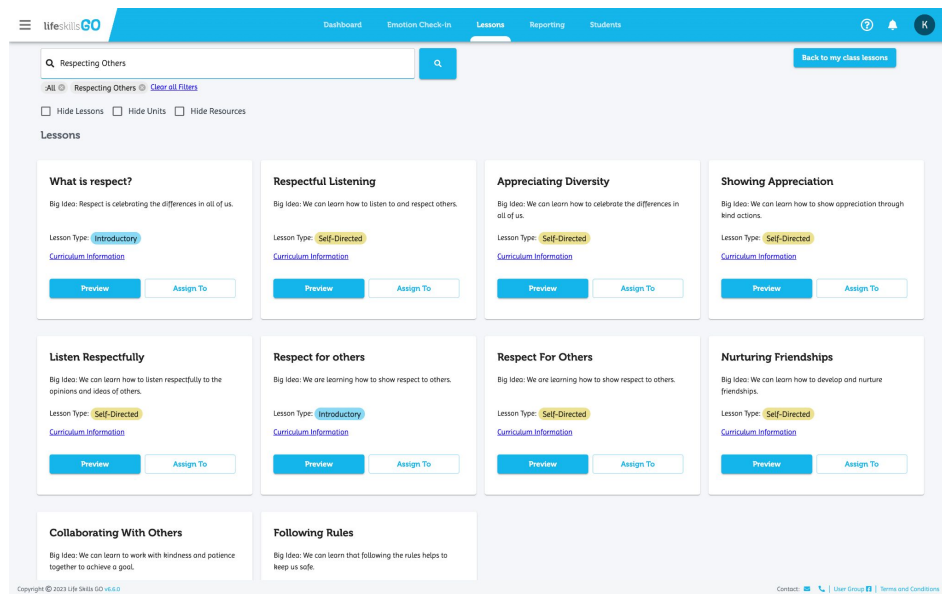

# Updates to the Lesson Assignment page

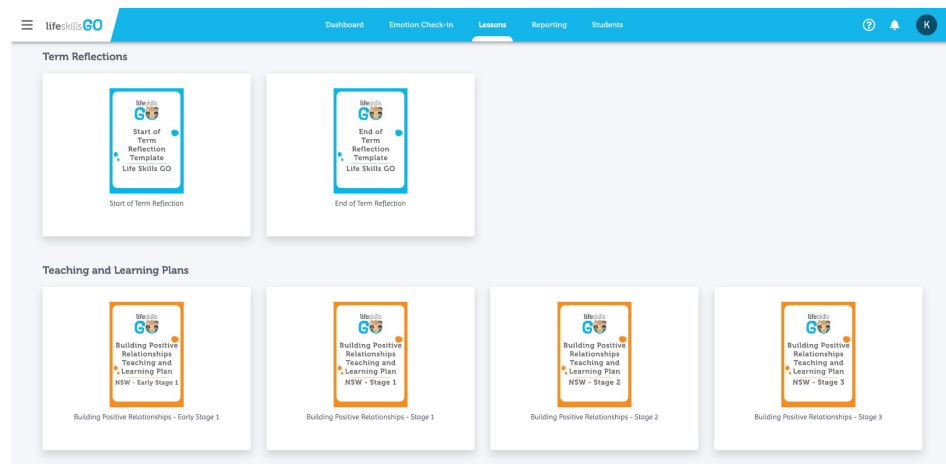
